1. Read John 4:1-42 together as a group.
  - a. What does it mean to worship God in spirit and in truth? How does our worship impact our evangelism?
  - b. What motivated this woman to share Christ with the rest of the town?

- c. Jesus exposed this woman's sin and need for a Savior before presenting Himself as the answer. How does this inform our evangelism?

2. Consider John 4:13-14. Jesus presents Himself as the ultimate satisfaction for this woman. (See also Jeremiah 2:12-13)
  - a. What are the idols that tend to capture your heart? Are you resting in Jesus alone for satisfaction in life?

- b. In your evangelism, are you offering Jesus as the ultimate source of satisfaction, or an add-on to their life?

3. What does this example of Jesus in evangelism teach you about how to share the gospel with others?
